CATEGORIES AND DEFINITION

CHERRIES ARE THE HERO INGREDIENT - ALL ENTRIES MUST CONTAIN CHERRIES

PIE: A dessert consisting of a filling (as of fruit or custard) or a meat dish baked in a pastry shell or topped with pastry or both.

TART: Pastry crust (usually shortcrust pastry). A tart is a baked dish consisting of a filling over a pastry base with an open top, not covered with pastry. The pastry is usually shortcrust pastry; the filling may be sweet or savoury.

CAKE OR SLICE (whole cake, 6 pieces of slice)

JAMS, PICKLES, CHUTNEYS

BEVERAGES

CHILDRENS CATEGORY: Cup cake or Cake.

CAFE RESTAURANT ENTRY; Any dish with cherry as the hero.
